

ORDINANCE NO. 1

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE BOUNDARIES OF THE TOWN OF GOSNELL, ARKANSAS: DESIGNATING THE OFFICERS IN SUCH TOWN: FIXING THE DATE OF COUNCIL MEETING: ACCEPTING THE DEDICATION OF STREETS AND ALLEYS WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF SAID TOWN: DECLARING AN EMERGENCY, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOSNELL, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. That the corporate boundaries of the Incorporated town of Gosnell as approved by County Court Order of Mississippi County are as follows:

DESCRIPTION

Section 2. That the officers of the Town of Gosnell, Arkansas shall be one (1) Mayor, one (1) Recorder-Treasurer, and five (5) Aldermen, who shall be qualified electors residing within the limits of the corporation and duly elected as provided by law and who shall hold their office until their successors are elected and qualified. That such Mayor, Recorder-Treasurer and Aldermen shall constitute the Council of the incorporated town, any four (4) of whom shall be a quorum for the transaction of business.

Section 3. That the council meeting shall be held regularly on SECOND TUES EACH MONTH at 7:30 P.M.

Section 4. That all streets and alleys within the corporate limits of the town that have been dedicated to the public by any deed, writing, or bill of assurance, properly acknowledged and recorded and in the office of Recorder of Deeds in this county are hereby accepted as public streets or alleys of the Town of Gosnell and the Mayor, by virtue of his authority, is hereby directed to take jurisdiction of the same on behalf of the town.

Section 5. That whereas this ordinance is necessary to properly start the function of the Town of Gosnell, as an incorporated town under the laws of the State of Arkansas; and

Whereas, this ordinance is necessary to insure proper health protection of the inhabitants for the protection of the general welfare of the inhabitants of said incorporated town through properly elected municipal officials; and

Whereas, this ordinance is deemed necessary to protect the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
