

ORDINANCE NO. 6

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SPEED RESTRICTIONS  
WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF GOSNELL, ARKANSAS

WHEREAS, the protection of the citizens of the Town of Gosnell is of concern to all inhabitants; and

WHEREAS, speed restrictions should be established for the protection and safety of all inhabitants;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOSNELL, ARKANSAS:

SECTION ONE: No person shall drive a vehicle on the streets of Gosnell at a speed greater than is reasonable and prudent under the conditions then existing.

SECTION TWO: When no special hazard exists, the following speeds shall be lawful, but any speed in excess of said limits shall be prima facie evidence that the speed is not reasonable or prudent and is unlawful:

(a) **THIRTY FIVE** miles an hour on all State and/or Federal Highways;

(b) **TWENTY FIVE** miles an hour on all other streets; and

(c) **TWENTY** miles an hour when passing a school within the designated school zones.

SECTION THREE: Violators of any provision of this ordinance shall be fined in an amount not less than five dollars (\$5.00) and not more than twenty five dollars (\$25.00).

SECTION FOUR: This ordinance shall take full force and effect immediately after its approval.
