

ORDINANCE NO. 25

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE KEEPING AND
RANGINE OF LIVESTOCK WITHIN THE LIMITS OF
THE CITY OF GOSNELL, ARKANSAS, PROVIDING
A PENALTY THEREFOR; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOSNELL, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, corpora-
tion or association to keep, maintain or range any cow, cattle, ox,
calf, swine, horse, mule, burro, sheep, goat or deer within the
corporate limits of the City of Gosnell, Arkansas.

SECTION 2. The prohibition contained in Section 1 hereinabove
shall apply both to the singular and plural of any of said species
of animals and shall comprehend both the male and female thereof.

SECTION 3. Any person, firm, corporation or association
violating the provisions hereof shall be guilty of a misdemeanor
and shall, upon conviction therefor, be fined in any amount not less
than \$5.00 nor more than \$25.00; and each day any of said livestock
shall be kept, maintained, or ranged within the corporate limits of
the City in violation of this Ordinance shall constitute a separate
offense.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict
herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be necessary
for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety
and welfare of this community and its citizens; therefore, an emergency

is hereby declared, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
