ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A CITY COURT IN AND FOR
THE CITY OF GOSNELL, ARKANSAS

BEFORE, be it enacted by the City Council of Gosnell, Arkansas;

ONE: There is hereby created the City Court of Gosnell, Arkansas,
