

ORDINANCE NO. 34

AN ORDINANCE SUBMITTING TO THE VOTERS OF THE CITY OF GOSNELL, ARKANSAS, THE QUESTION OF ANNEXATION TO THE CITY OF CERTAIN CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY.

Whereas, it appears to the City Council and the Mayor that certain hereinafter described land contiguous to the present city limits of the City of Gosnell, Arkansas, should be annexed as it is necessary for the growth and development of the City.

BE IT HEREDY ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOSNELL, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. That there shall be submitted to the legal voters of the City of Gosnell, Arkansas, to be voted upon at a special election on April 29, 1975, the issue of whether to annex property hereinafter described to the City of Gosnell, Arkansas, and the officials of this City are directed to take the necessary action so that said issue and question may be presented to the voters to decide whether the following described lands should be annexed:

A tract of land situated in the Chickasawba District of Mississippi County, Arkansas, being the South 825 feet of the West 1320 feet of the fractional Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4) of fractional Section Thirty (30), Township Sixteen (16) North, Range Eleven (11) East of the Fifth Principal Meridian and containing 25 acres, more or less.

Section 2. The issue shall be presented to the voters on the ballot in said election as follows:

"For annexation of territory proposed in Ordinance No. 34."

"Against annexation of territory proposed in Ordinance No. 34."

Section 3. That all qualified electors of the City of Gosnell, Arkansas shall be eligible to vote upon said issue as well as all qualified electors in that area sought to be annexed.

Section 4. All necessary services needed, including water, sewer, fire and police protection, will be supplied within three (3) years after the annexation becomes final to that area to be annexed, fire protection and police protection being available immediately and water and sewer services being available during the third year following the annexation.

Section 5. This Ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare and it being necessary to proceed as quickly as possible to annex certain territory to the City

of Gosnell, Arkansas, for their well being, an emergency is hereby declared and this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
