

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 34
AND RESCINDING ELECTION IN CONNECTION THEREWITH

WHEREAS, the City Council did on April 8, 1975 pass an Ordinance setting an election for April 29, 1975 considering the annexation of certain property to the City of Gosnell, and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the City Council that the City of Blytheville, Arkansas, which is also contiguous to such property plans to file legal proceedings to prevent such annexation.

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOSNELL, ARKANSAS:

Section 1: That Ordinance No. 34 setting a special election on April 29, 1975 for the annexation of certain territory to the City of Gosnell should be rescinded and the election for such date cancelled.

Section 2: That the City of Gosnell should through its legal and authorized representatives including its Council and Mayor negotiate and meet with the representatives of the City of Blytheville to determine if something can be worked out regarding such territory so as to save both cities the unnecessary expenses involved in a contest concerning which city is entitled to annex this territory within its corporate boundaries.

Section 3: This Ordinance being necessary for preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare and in order to rescind the election and to save unnecessary expenses, an emergency is hereby declared and this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
