

ORDINANCE NO. 38

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE ORDERLY BURNING OF LITTER, WASTE, GARBAGE AND REFUSE IN THE CITY OF GOSNELL, ARKANSAS, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOSNELL, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. In order to provide for the orderly burning of litter, waste, garbage, grass and refuse in the City of Gosnell, Arkansas, no person shall hereafter be allowed to burn any such litter, waste, garbage, grass and refuse, etc., in the City of Gosnell, Arkansas, unless such items shall be burned in a metal container so designed as to prevent the flying of sparks, embers and small particles of fire or unless such items are burned while being attended by an adult person at all times while the burning takes place.

Section 2. No person shall proceed to burn any grass on any lots or other areas unless approval is obtained from the Gosnell Fire Department or its authorized representatives and arrangements made for the burning. Any person, firm or business shall, for violation of any provision of this Ordinance, upon conviction, be fined in any sum not more than \$25.00, and they shall have as a further fine a sum equal to the expense of the Fire Department should their violation of any provision of this Ordinance be found to be the cause of any fire necessitating the need for the Gosnell Fire Department.

Section 3. Whereas, the burning of litter, waste, garbage, grass and refuse in the City of Gosnell has grown to be a nuisance, together with being a possible danger to the citizens of the City of Gosnell, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
