

ORDINANCE NO. 44

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 23 PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF ORDINANCE NO. 23 WHICH REQUIRES PREMISES TO BE KEPT FREE FROM WEEDS, GRASS, GARBAGE, RUBBAGE AND OTHER UNSIGHTLY AND UNSANITARY ARTICLES, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOSNELL, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: All provisions of Ordinance No. 23 shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 2: Any owner or owners having received notice of the violation of Ordinance No. 23 as provided therein shall, in addition to the remedies that are provided in Ordinance No. 23, be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall, upon conviction therefor, be fined an amount not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$25.00; and each day of such violation may constitute a separate offense at the discretion of the Court.

SECTION 3: It has been determined this Ordinance is necessary and is vital to the health, welfare and safety of the public, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
