

ORDINANCE NO. 49

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE SALE AND DISCHARGE
OF FIREWORKS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF GOSNELL, ARKANSAS

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Gosnell,
Arkansas:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to sell or discharge any item of fireworks within the City Limits of Gosnell, Arkansas, except that the Mayor shall have authority to permit supervised public displays of fireworks.

Section 2. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a violation and upon conviction shall be fined any sum not more than One Hundred (\$100.00) for each offense.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts or ordinance in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. Emergency. It being necessary to preserve the public peace and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Gosnell, Arkansas, and other persons who have business therein, and it being found that the selling and discharging of fireworks within the City Limits of Gosnell, Arkansas, constitutes a hazard to both life and property, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
