

ORDINANCE NO. 51

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING PAYMENT TO ALDERMEN OF  
\$10.00 PER MONTH FOR SERVICES RENDERED THE CITY OF  
GOSNELL, ARKANSAS AND DECLARING EMERGENCY THEREFOR

WHEREAS, the City of Gosnell was incorporated almost ten (10) years ago,  
and

WHEREAS, the population of the City and the duties of the elected Aldermen  
have duly increased requiring great time and attention, and

WHEREAS, the Aldermen have never received any compensation for their  
services rendered although much time is necessary in order to devote the at-  
tention that is necessary in order to serve as Aldermen,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Gosnell,  
Arkansas:

Section 1. That all duly elected Aldermen of the City of Gosnell are hereby  
authorized payment of \$10.00 per month for services in such capacity as Alder-  
men beginning February 1, 1979.

Section 2. That the City Recorder or other authorized representatives  
controlling the payment of expenses for the City are hereby authorized to  
make payment as provided herein from the general funds of the City and to  
the Aldermen as of February 1, 1979.

Section 3. That all Ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith are  
hereby repealed.

Section 4. That the Council has determined that payment to the Aldermen  
for services rendered has been long since overdue and that in order to make  
possible the immediate payment an emergency is hereby declared to exist, this  
Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the betterment of  
the City, together with the peace and safety of the City and this Ordinance  
shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
