

ORDINANCE NO. 52

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING PAYMENT TO MEMBERS OF
CITY PLANNING COMMISSION THE SUM OF \$5.00 FOR EACH
MEETING ATTENDED OF THE CITY PLANNING COMMISSION
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY THEREFOR

WHEREAS, there exists in the City of Gosnell a City Planning Commission which has among its duties the consideration of the comprehensive planning of the City together with all rezoning applications and other matters involving planning for the City of Gosnell, and

WHEREAS, it is felt that attendance and participation in the regular monthly meetings will be increased if some compensation is received for services rendered the Planning Commission, and

WHEREAS, the members of the Planning Commission have heretofore received no compensation whatsoever for their services,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Gosnell, Arkansas:

Section 1. That the duly, properly, designated and appointed members of the City Planning Commission are hereby authorized the payment of \$5.00 for each meeting attended of the City Planning Commission with said payment to be authorized after the passage of this Ordinance.

Section 2. That the City Recorder and other authorized representatives of the City necessary for the payment to them for such services are hereby authorized to make payment from the general funds of the City of Gosnell to the members of the Planning Commission for each meeting attended of the City Planning Commission after the passage of this Ordinance.

Section 3. That all Ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. The Council has determined that it would be to the best interest of the functioning and operation of the City Planning Commission that the members thereof be paid for each meeting attended and it is felt that this Ordinance should be passed and declared to exist immediately. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, this Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of public health, peace and safety of the City of Gosnell shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
