

ORDINANCE NO. 62

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING THE REQUIREMENTS OF
COMPETITIVE BIDS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Gosnell is in immediate need to have
some repair work done on certain streets; and

WHEREAS, Bass, Inc., a corporation, has proposed the
application of a slurry seal on certain City streets; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to have this work done immediately
without the necessity of advertising and taking competitive bids;
and

WHEREAS, the City of Gosnell feels the requirements of such
competitive bids are not under the existing circumstances feasible
or practical.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the
City of Gosnell, Arkansas, to-wit:


SECTION I. The City of Gosnell is hereby authorized to
enter into a Contract with Bass, Inc. for the application of
a slurry seal over streets to be designated by the City.

SECTION II. The City of Gosnell is authorized to pay such
contractor the sum of \$.97 per square yard for such work on
streets agreed upon.


SECTION III. It is not deemed practical or feasible to
fulfill the requirements of competitive bidding and such
requirements are waived as provided under Arkansas Statutes
§ 19-4425.

SECTION IV. This ordinance being necessary for the immediate
preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens
of the City of Gosnell, an emergency is hereby declared to exist
and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and
after its passage.
