

ORDINANCE NO. 79

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS OF ORDINANCES 16, 18, 63 and 66 PERTAINING TO INSPECTION AND/OR TAPPING FEES TO A SEWER SYSTEM OF CITY GOSNELL; ALLOWING CITY COUNCIL TO SET SUCH FEES; FOR OTHER PURPOSES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, a tapping fee for connection to the city sewer system is referred to in Section 1 (b) of Ordinance No. 16; an inspection fee is referred to in Art. IV, Section 2, of Ordinance No. 18; and tapping fees are referred to in Section 1 (b) of Ordinances 63 and 66; and

WHEREAS, the City Council feels it would be desirable to the City to provide that the council could, upon proper motion and a majority vote, determine what inspection and/or tapping fees should be allowed for connection to the city sewer systems:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOSNELL, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 1 (b) of Ordinance 16; Art. IV, Section 2, of Ordinance No. 18; Sections 1 (b) of Ordinances 63 and 66 are hereby amended so that each respective section of said Ordinances shall read as follows:

The City Council can, at its discretion, set any inspection and/or tapping fees that will be charged for connections to the city sewer system; that such charges will be reflected by proper notation in the Council's minutes following proper motion and passage by a majority vote of the Council.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

This Ordinance being necessary for the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Gosnell, Arkansas, an emergency is hereby declared and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
