

ORDINANCE NO. 91

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE
ELECTION OF ALDERMEN BY WARDS

WHEREAS, under the authority of Arkansas Statutes Annotated, Section 19-1002.7, a City of the First Class may provide that aldermen be elected by ward;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF GOSNELL, ARKANSAS, to-wit:

Section 1: Election of aldermen in all general and special elections shall be by ward for terms beginning January 1, 1988 and thereafter.

Section 2: Candidates for the office of alderman shall be placed in nomination upon Petition of the qualified electors of the ward to be represented, with the Petition to be signed by no less than 10 or more than 50 qualified electors of the ward.

Section 3: Two aldermen shall be elected from each ward by the qualified electors of that ward at each general election, as well as in special elections. Candidates shall reside in their respective wards and shall be elected only by qualified voters residing within their ward.
