

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING BID REQUIREMENTS ON
JOINT VENTURE CONSTRUCTION OF WATER LOOP
WITH GOSNELL WATER ASSOCIATION AND DECLARING
AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Gosnell has entered into an Agreement with the Gosnell Water Association, a non-profit corporation, for the construction of an eight inch water line which will run from Bevill Street to South Gosnell Street primarily along the location of the old railroad; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the construction is to be shared by the City and Gosnell Water Association with the City's portion in excess of that requiring competitive bidding;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF GOSNELL, ARKANSAS,
TO-WIT:

SECTION 1: That in view of the joint venture between Gosnell Water Association and the City of Gosnell for the construction of the eight inch water line from Bevill Street to South Gosnell Street it would be impractical to require competitive bidding.

SECTION 2: The requirements of competitive bidding may be waived where such procedure is deemed not feasible and the City of Gosnell feels that in this situation it is not feasible because of the joint venture and payment by the City of only one half of the cost of the construction.

SECTION 3: The City of Gosnell does, therefore, waive the requirements of competitive bidding on the construction of the water line in which it is involved with the Gosnell Water Association as described above.


SECTION 4: In view of the fact construction is being undertaken, an emergency is hereby declared and this Ordinance shall take effect at the time of its passage.
